Use lower carbon – reusable face masks, as COVID is here to stay.

Get our patient group involved in spreading the word to other patients to be carbon friendly

Monthly group discussions to identify areas where we could improve our carbon footprint

New topics each month to discuss at meetings.

Look at medicines, use starter packs, low carbon options – choices appropriate prescribing and DE prescribing. To discuss at Doctors monthly meetings.

Look at waste and medicine and medicines packaging. Look at recycling – get some new recycling boxes to split into categories card, plastic, paper, batteries and inhalers to help with our carbon footprint.
